## WHY DO leaves CHANGE COLORS experiment



### LEAF SCIENCE EXPERIMENT:

#### MATERIALS:

- Mason Jars (3-4)
- Large Coffee Filters
- Leaves
- Rubbing Alcohol



#### PROCEDURE:

Gather fall-colored leaves (at least 3-4 different colors). Grind up/tear each color leaves into small pieces. Place leaves in each mason jar and cover with rubbing alcohol. Make a cone shape with each coffee filter and place the pointed tip in each mason jar. Watch as the coffee filter absorbs the color from the leaves.

## Fall Pretzels

### Ingredients:

- ✓ ¾ cup White candy melts
- ✓ ¼ cup Orange candy melts
- ✓ 6 Pretzel rods
- ✓ Fall themed sprinkles

Hand Dipped Fall Pretzels



### Instructions:

Melt white candy melts in a mug in the microwave for 1 minute. Stir the candy melts and microwave them for another 30 seconds. Repeat the stirring and microwaving until the candy melts are completely melted. Dip the pretzel in the mug with the melted white candy and spoon some on the pretzel to get it halfway covered. Shake off the excess candy back into the mug. Place on a cooling rack to cool the candy. While it hardens, you can melt the orange candy melts. When the pretzels have hardened, drizzle on the orange melted candy with a spoon. Cover the area under your workspace with wax paper to catch the mess. Now add the fall sprinkles. Place the pretzels on a rack or wax paper to harden and then enjoy!
