

PAPER BAG BUTTERFLY

Supplies:

- White paper lunch bag
- Acrylic paint (any color)
- 6" heart doilies,
- Dot markers or markers
- Paint brush
- Pipe cleaner (cut in half)
- Black marker
- Large googly eyes
- Tape
- Glue



Instructions:

Start by painting the paper bag and let it dry. While paper bag is drying use markers to decorate the heart doilies. Fold over the end of the heart doily and glue it down to make a straight edge. Glue doilies to the front inside flaps on the sides of the paper bag. Glue googly eyes onto your butterfly and draw a smile with black marker. Next, curl pipe cleaners around your finger and tape them to the back of your paper bag to make antennae.

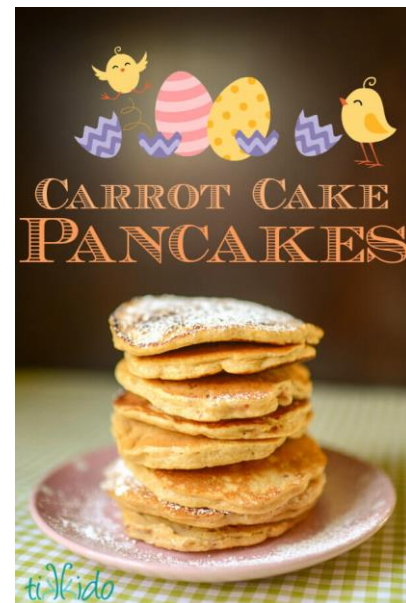

Carrot Cake Pancakes

Ingredients:

- 3 Cups grated carrots
- 2 Tbs butter, melted
- 1 Cup sugar
- 2 tsp salt
- 2 tsp cinnamon
- 1/4 tsp ground nutmeg
- 2 tbs baking powder
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 3 Cups flour
- 2 ½ cups milk
- 2 Tbs oil



Instructions:

Sautee grated carrots in the two tablespoons of butter until carrots are soft. Combine sugar, oil, milk, and beaten eggs. In a separate bowl, combine dry ingredients. Mix wet ingredients, dry ingredients, and sauteed carrots together. Cook on a slightly cooler than usual griddle.
