Ingredients:

- Cake Mix
- Pretzels
- Candies for eyes & nose
- Chocolate Frosting
- Black Frosting



Procedure:

1. Bake cupcakes of your choosing.
I took the easy way out on these and made chocolate cupcakes from a box mix.
2. Frost with chocolate frosting.
3. Top with pretzels for the antlers, a Nilla Wafer for the face, white M&Ms for the eyes (or any other type of white candy), black icing for the eyeballs, and brown and red candies for the nose (I used peanut butter M&Ms and Cadbury chocolate balls).

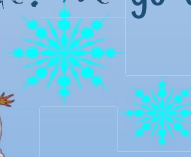

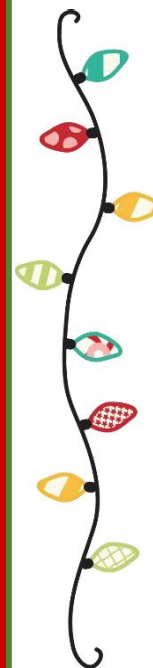
Scrabble Ornaments

Materials

- Scrabble Letters
- Low Temp Hot Glue Gun
- Ribbon
- Twine
- Jingle Bells (optional)

Instructions

1. Start by laying out a piece of ribbon and putting your scrabble tiles to spell the name. Leave extra space on top for the bow and to fold over.
2. Hot glue the pieces on the ribbon then the bow.
3. Tie a piece of twine in a circle and put through the top of the ribbon.
4. Fold over the ribbon and glue it down.
5. Glue on a string of bells in the back or leave as is!
